As part of our Year 5 History Theme work on 'What Changed' we are planning a visit to Bradford Industrial Museum on **Wednesday 4th October 2017**. We will be leaving school at 8.50am and travelling by coach to Bradford where we will spend the morning taking part in a museum run workshop called *Weaving in the Mill*. During the workshop, the children will try their hand at the sorting, carding, spinning and weaving skills that would have been familiar to children who lived in our area a hundred and fifty years ago.

In the afternoon, our work will link to the English curriculum and we will be using different spaces in the museum to write diary entries in role as Victorian children. So that we can get the very best experience from our visit, the children will be asked to wear Victorian style clothing and for lunchtime, to bring the kind of food that a Victorian mill working child may have eaten. We will be asking the children to carry out their own research into this prior to the visit.

We would really appreciate two additional adult helpers and if you are able to volunteer, and if you are happy to dress up (!), that would be wonderful! Please indicate on the form below.
